VICBRED



1. VICBRED SUPER SERIES PROGRAM

- \$1.6M Race Series for 2, 3 and 4yo's
 - Pacers Series
 - Separate Series For Male and Female Horses
 - Heats of \$8,000
 - Semi Finals of \$20,000
 - Finals of \$100,000













1. VICBRED SUPER SERIES PROGRAM\$1.6M Race Series for 2, 3 and 4yo's
Trotters Series
Male and Female Horses Combined
Heats of \$8,000
Final of \$50,000













2. VICBRED WIN BONUSES

- \$2,750 Bonus Payable for First 2YO Win and First 3YO Win.
- If Bonus Not Won as 2YO or 3YO, Bonus Payable as a 4YO.
- Distribution: 80% Owner and 5% to Trainer, Driver, Breeder & Studmaster
- \$1.6M Paid Out Annually











3. OTHER VICBRED RACES

 Over 100 'other' Vicbred Races across a variety of ages and classes for both pacers and trotters are conducted
 \$1M distributed in these other races













4. VICBRED BREEDER BONUS

Cash payment of 7.5% of the stake of a race made direct to the Breeder every time that a Vicbred Horse wins a 2YO, 3YO or 4YO race in Victoria or a Group 2YO, 3YO or 4YO race in Australia.

4. VICBRED BREEDER BONUS

- Bonus increased to 10% for current foal crop
- \$550K Distributed to Breeders in 2007/08. This will grow to \$1M by 2011/12
- Fundamental to the Success of Vicbred
- Significant Improvements in Quality of Racing Stock
- Foal Numbers have remained higher than what they otherwise would have been













4. VICBRED BREEDER BONUS

- Breeders ultimately determine the eligibility of their stock
- Breeders seek to maximise the return on their investment.
- HRV believes that Breeder Bonus Schemes are crucial for maximising foal numbers in Australia

BREEDERS CROWN



- Richest Sweepstakes Series in Australasia
- Series is open to the progeny of any nominated broodmare
- Heats, Repechages, Semi Finals and Final for Pacers
- Heats, Repechages and Final for Trotters









BREEDERS CROWN



 Series is currently restricted to 2YO's and 3YO's
 2YO Pacing Finals \$314,000

- > 2YO Trotting Final \$165,000
- > 3YO Pacing Finals \$168,000
- > 3YO Trotting Final \$92,000

Heats conducted in NZ and in each State

RECENT INITIATIVES & FUTURE PLANS

- Series extended to 4yo's in 2009
- > Open Age FFA races introduced in 2008
- By 2011, Australasian Breeders Crown Final Day will consist of ten Group 1 Finals.
- \$2.1M Series encourages breeding and purchase of young ABC eligible stock









AUSTRALIAN PACING GOLD



- Each year APG sells over 600 yearlings
- Yearlings sold by APG are eligible for the rich \$1.6M APG Futurity Race Series.
- Race Series is for 2YO's and 3YO's
- > 1st round of 2YO Heats in Vic, NSW and QLD.
- > 2YO Finals of \$300,000
- > 3YO Finals of \$100,000
- Fully sustained 2yo's also eligible for \$1,500 Gold Bonus for first 2yo win
