STEWARDS' REPORTS

GLOBE DERBY PARK — SATURDAY, 7th FEBRUARY, 1976

Race 1 T. Hansberry Stakes

SPRING LOGAN (L. Sugars) and TOTEM CHIEF (H. Hocking) both missed the start and are now out of future mobile barrier draws. OSTARJA (R. Sugars) and GEORGE McELWYN (R. Jacques) received checks at the start from the two galloping horses.

TOTEM CHIEF choked and fell with one lap to travel, a later examination revealed the horse also bled and it was barred from racing until after midnight on 7th May, 1976.

F. Whitfield (DAPPER ADIOS) was fined \$50 for prodding his horse with the whip.

It was noted that CHANTILADE (C. Webster) took fright at something and mixed its gait each time in the home straight.

Race 2 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Trotters

Championship (1st Qual. Div.)

STORMY MEADOW galloped out of the barrier, driver M. Paddon was directed to shorten his grips and in future ensure that this horse was controllable.

ARMBRO TIME (C. Hurley) broke after travelling approximately 400 metres.

SIR VOLO (R. Jacques) broke with 500 metres to run.

ROCKIN DALE (C. Redwood) broke on the first turn.

BUNDANOON PRINCE (G. Williams) broke with one and a half laps to travel.

ROCKIN DALE (C. Redwood) missed the start and will remain out of the draw.

C. O'Dwyer was granted permission to use a shadow roll on FIERY LUCK in future as this horse jumped twice in running.

Race 3 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Pacers

Championship (1st Qual. Div.)

KINGS MEAD (J. Lesuer) dwelt at the start checking PURE STEEL (F. Kersley).

SPORTING SON (B. Clarke) broke shortly after the start.

DIAGO (R. Glasgow) missed the start and is now out of future standing start barrier draws.

CAPTAIN HARCOURT (T. Knowles) missed the start.

Approaching the first turn YALLARA (K. Murray) hung down against the driver's efforts causing a check to KING FROST (B. Gath).

KINGS MEAD (J. Lesuer) went to the line hard held, being unable to obtain a run.

Race 4 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Trotters

Championship (2nd Qual. Div.)

FRAMALDA (K. Newman) broke on the first turn. PETER PILADE (P. Connole) broke after travelling 400 metres. CEE AR (C. De Fillipi) and SLANE (J. Carmichael) both broke on the last turn.

After approximately 150 metres COURT JESTER forced out from inside TRAIL OF GOLD (B. Nolan) causing that horse to become unbalanced and break gait. D. Fitzpatrick (COURT JESTER) was suspended from driving at licensed trotting meetings until after midnight on 11th February, 1976, for careless driving.

The owners of COURT JESTER scratched the horse on the grounds that D. Fitzpatrick was the only person that had ever driven him and through him being suspended they considered the horse too valuable to be driven by anyone else. He was fined \$200 as the reasons were deemed to be unacceptable. COURT JESTER is automatically barred from racing until after the final of the Trotters Championship on the 14th February, 1976.

Race 5 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Pacers Championship (2nd Qual. Div.)

M. Evans (NEVADA SMOKE) was fined \$10 for allowing his horse to drift off in the run home.

6. The first to have a lottery run in conjunction with it. 'The Benson & Hedges 1976 Inter-Dominion Special Lottery'. Buy a ticket and have a chance to win \$200,000.
7. The first to be heralded by a parade through the main street of Adelaide, 600 horses will take part in the 'Wonderful World of Horses'. This has been organised by the Elizabeth Rotary Club and they have also organised a Gymkhana on the night of Wednesday, 18th February, at Globe Derby Park.

A special Inter-Dominion wine bottled by Angle Vale wineries will be available. The S.A. Brewing Company has special Inter-Dominion West End Draught beer cans on sale.

The Hall of Fame of Australia will be opened for the first time and everybody is urged to visit it during the series. A collectors' gem of special Reserve Bin Port to commemorate the official opening of the Hall is on sale for \$10.

The Club, together with associated bodies, will hold functions that we wish all visitors to attend and enjoy the company and friendship of South Australian Trotting enthusiasts. On Sunday, 15th February, commencing at 7 p.m. a country and western barbecue and dance will be held at the Angle Vale Winery arranged by S.A. Ladies Committee BOTRA. Tickets will be \$6 all inclusive. On Friday, 20th February, at 7.30 p.m., a dinner dance will be held at the Joe Oberdan Convention Centre and the cost is \$20 a double all inclusive. Tickets for these functions will be available to all at the secretary's office and must be purchased in advance.

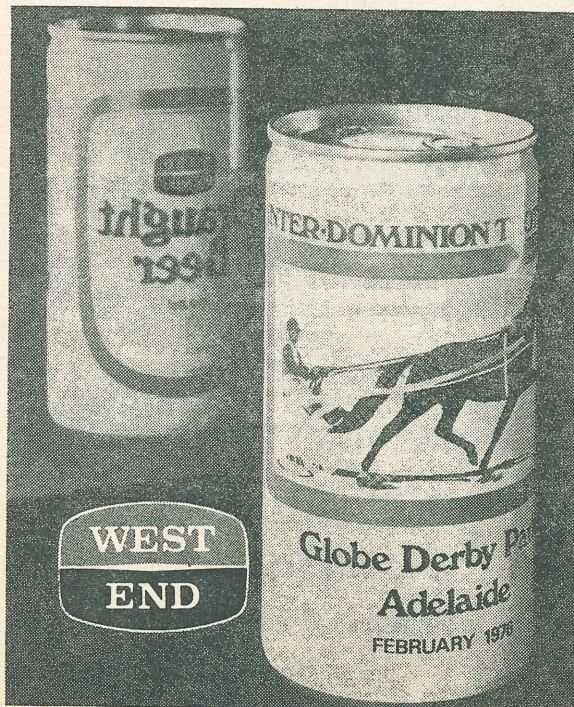

STEWARDS' REPORT (cont.)

The Stewards noted the different performance of NEVADA SMOKE compared with its last start when over 2660 metres it met interference with one lap to go and was forced four wide. In view of the particularly fast last half of that race when compared with the fact that NEVADA SMOKE led tonight and dictated the pace over 2250 metres, no action was taken.

MICRON (J. Carmichael) missed the start badly and became tailed off and was pulled up. It has been declared out of future standing start barrier draws.

Turning into the back straight on the last lap, D. Anderson (ROYAL FORCE) forced out from inside ROYAL GAZE (K. Pocock) and was suspended from driving at licensed trotting meetings until after midnight on the 11th February, 1976 for careless driving.

Race 6 Benson & Hedges Inter-Dominion Pacers Championship (3rd Qual. Div.)

HIGH ADIOS (M. Rodda) and WILLIE RIP (F. Day) missed the start.

After an enquiry into an incident on the home turn when ADIOS VICTOR (A. Bray) shifted ground F. Kersley (TYPHSON) was found not guilty of a charge of careless driving and A. Bray was advised to exercise all care otherwise a penalty would be imposed.

Race 7 Grayling Four-Years-Old Stakes

After an enquiry as to the reason for ARAJARCA (W. Butterworth) obtaining a run on the last turn whilst inside SILVER ECHO (A. Lee) it was found that A. Lee (SILVER ECHO) had no control of his horse and allowed it to shift ground. He was suspended from licensed trotting meetings until after midnight on 11th February, 1976.

AURYAN (C. Lewis) and SILVER ECHO (A. Lee) could not hold their position at the start and have been declared out of future mobile barrier draws.
