PEDESTRIAN: Made her debut when she met with a check, settled down at the rear, swept forward in the middle stages and battled on to be a distant 3rd to Thanks Fella and Gold Vein Bunbury 1700m (2.12.1) last Sat. Set the pace, but was inclined to hang when a 1900m trial winner at GP last Tues. Is a promising filly.

DANDY DAX: A very smart colt who has won at his only two starts. Started from 10m and finished powerfully from 6th at the bell to win effortlessly from Katie s Lad and Big Rastus Northam 1700m (2.8.6) March 10. That was his first run since a brilliant victory at Pinjarra on Nov. 2.

MEADOW FELLA: Worked hard without a trail before dashing to the lead 500m from home and winning from Rosso Cute GP 1900m mobile (2.1.9) last Fri. At his only other start he was a stylish winner at Pinjarra over 1750m Dec. 12.

BEAU SHEWANNA: Will be making his debut. Has appeared in four trials for three wins. Set the pace and was an effortless trial winner GP 1900m last Tues.

FAST CREED: Was checked at the start and always at the rear when 8th to Dietmar Schott Bunbury 1700m Feb. 27. A well-bred colt who has been unplaced at his four starts.

BLACKABY: Did not show up when he broke in running and finished 9th behind Roving Report York 1675m Feb. 24. At his only other start was 2nd to New Bromac Busseton 1728m (2.15.3) Jan. 23. Unplaced in a GP trial last Tues.

KATIE S LAD: Was smartest into stride, trailed the pacemaker Rosso Cute, but lacked sparkle when a fading 6th in a field of six behind Meadow Fella GP 1900m mobile (2.4.4) last Fri. Finished 2nd in the country at four of his other six starts.

BYE LARGESSE: Had a good run in 4th place when a fading 5th in a field of six behind Meadow Fella GP 1900m mobile (2.4.2) last Fri. That was his first start in a race. Has won trials at GP and RR.

ISLAMIC: Was 5th on the rails at the bell, showed abundant pace to dash forward to momentarily loom as a threat approaching the home turn, but hung out badly and finished 3rd to Meadow Fella GP 1900m mobile (2.2.9) last Fri.

RED ARANIA: Ran on solidly from 7th on the rails at the bell to be 3rd to Flying Romeo GP 1900m (2.9.7) March 5. Handy all the way when he won from the pacemaker Sheer Pace Bunbury 1700m (2.9.9) a week earlier.

DARK PIALO: Was 5th on the rails for most of the way when a sound 6th to Hanover Attack GP 2275m (2.8) Feb. 9. Broke a losing sequence of 23 when he worked hard in the middle stages before beating Chief Rowan York 2640m at his previous start on Jan. 27.

PITCH BLENDE: Started from 10m, was 6th on the rails at the bell and met with a severe check on the home turn when 9th to Cool Charlie GP 2275m (2.6.9) last Fri. Previous form sound and his past 48 starts have produced eight wins and eight places.

LYN S HEAVEN: Ran on strongly, out wide, from 7th at the bell to be 4th to Eldora GP 2275m (2.8.1) last Fri. Won in good style from San Eltrym RR 2500m a week earlier.

COOL CHARLIE: Impressed when he set the pace and won from Miner Karamea GP 2275m (2.6.6) last Fri. Set a fast pace and won from Creston Court Cunderdin 2500m at his previous start on Feb. 17.

UNDER CONTROL: Was a 16/1 chance when he sustained a strong run, out wide, from midfield to win from Classic Garry Bunbury 2500m (2.5.2) last Mon. Unplaced at his previous six starts, but is a smart pacer and winner of ten races and \$25,245.

SAN ELTRYM: Was 9th at the bell and ran on strongly to finish a close-up 9th (on the extreme outside of the track) behind Eldora GP 2275m (2.8.3) last Fri. Consistent, and his previous 16 starts produced one win and 11 places.

SEATTLE PRINCE: Was hemmed in on the rails in 9th place at the bell and ran on, out very wide, when 5th to Pacing Darne GP 2275m mobile (2.4.9) March 9. Smart and won at four of his previous nine starts.

FESTINO: Surprised at his first start for two and a half months when he worked hard without a trail for most of the way and won from Al s Vision RR 2500m (2.9) Feb. 26.

MINER KARAMEA: Started from 20m and maintained his good form when he finished fast from 9th at the bell to be 2nd to Cool Charlie GP 2275m (2.5.8) last Fri. His past 19 starts have produced one win and nine places.

MIDDY ELECT: Broke a losing sequence of 18 when he enjoyed a good run in 4th place for most of the way, took the lead 300m from home and dead-heated with Greenacre Girl Northam 2500m (2.9.4) March 10.

KING S SHADOW: Was badly checked soon after the start and was pulled up in the race won by Pacing Darne GP 2275m March 5. Ran on fast from 9th in the middle stages to win from The Senator Pinjarra 2850m (2.5.4) at his previous start. In excellent form and has strong claims.

GRETA S GUY: Worked hard to take the lead after a lap when a fighting 4th to Lady Dearne Bunbury 2500m last Sat. Started slowly from 10m, but dashed to the front with two laps to go and won from Ben Rowan RR 2500m (2.9.5) a week earlier.

2275 METRES MOBILE

MOBILE KARAMEA: A promising colt whose five starts in the country have produced two wins and three placings. Led when 2nd to Matai Bret Bunbury 2500m (2.8.9) last Sat. Won impressively at Pinjarra and York at his two previous starts

BARBARINO: Enjoyed a good run in 4th place for most of the way and fought on doggedly when 3rd to Torrevean Derby and Leetron GP 2275m (2.6.2) last Fri. Handy throughout when a fast-finishing 2nd to Unit Four RR 2200m a week earlier.

PACIFIC SAKI(LATE TARASAKI): Began badly and was charging up towards the leaders approaching the home turn when accidentally struck by the whip and broke and dropped back to 11th behind Matai Bret Bunbury 2500m last Sat. Won at Cunderdin and Northam at his two previous starts. Is the winner of five races. Led and covered the final 400m in 29.1 sec. to win a 2275m GP trial last Tues.

APOLLINAIRE: Set the pace and impressed with a five-length win over Wallara Way Northam 2150m mobile (2.3.8) March 10. Has had 15 starts for four wins and five places.

TOLIVER TOBY: Ran on fast from 6th at the bell to take the lead 350m from home when a fading 3rd to Armista Harvey 2150m mobile (2.7.6) March 1. Showed promise with a good win at Northam two starts before that.

LIEBCHEN LADY(LATE JUDY S GIRL): Was 7th in the middle stages and was forced four wide in the final circuit when a slightly disappointing 5th to Benemerenza GP 2275m mobile (2.4.2) March 9. Made an excellent WA debut when she ran on from 3rd at the bell to win from Paleface Rajah and Apollinaire RR 2200m mobile (2.2.8) Feb. 26. Won a race at Addington as a two-year-old.

Keys was unable to properly steer AGITATION when the cords from that pacer's ear plugs became heavily entangled in the near side rein. As a result AGITATION contacted the sulky wheel of TARPOT DIANE (L. Marriott) and shifted abruptly outwards onto PITCH BLENDE (P. Schrader) checking that horse and almost dislodging K. Keys from the sulky of AGITATION. K. Keys was advised that he must ensure that his gear in future is in order and that no repetition of such an incident re-occurs.

RACE 2: On return to scale a protest was lodged by S. Harney the driver of the 4th placegetter against PRINCE HALAYR (R. Sangalli) being declared 2nd on the ground of interference in the home straight. After taking evidence from the reinsmen concerned, viewing the films, acting on their own observations and bearing in mind the margin involved the Stewards dismissed the protest and the all clear given. The Stewards found that in the early stages of the home straight LYN S HEAVEN (S. Harney) and SHERMAN (L. Froyland) had engaged carts for a short distance when LYN S HEAVEN received some pressure from PRINCE HALAYR (R. Sangalli) shifting ground on its inside. Over the concluding stages both PRINCE HALAYR (R. Sangalli) and VAGABOND BOY (G. Sims) experienced difficulty in obtaining clear runs. SHERMAN (L. Froyland) missed the start.

RACE 3: The start was delayed due to VIA VISTA (W. Duffy) kicking over a hople. When the start was effected CLASSIC PRINCE (R. Denney) and SKIPTAR (J. Schrader) commenced badly. In future standing starts CLASSIC PRINCE will be excluded from the draw. VIA VISTA (W. Duffy) sustained a flat tyre in running.

NOTICE TO PATRONS

CONDITIONS OF RACING

All races to be run under the Rules of Racing made under the Constitution and Rules of the Western Australian Trotting Association.

In all races when two or more horses are on identical marks, the horse whose name appears first will occupy the No. 1 pole position, the other positions following in rotation.

REFUSAL OF NOMINATION

The Committee may, in its absolute discretion, at any time after receipt of a nomination, cancel the same without giving any reason therefore.

RE-HANDICAPPING OF HORSES

If, after the handicaps are declared for a race a horse wins or is placed in another race, the handicap of that horse may be re-adjusted by the Handicapper.

STARTING

Horses are under the starter's orders after the whistle has been blown to take their positions at the barriers.

PROTESTS

A driver of a competing horse placed 1st to fifth inclusive, may protest against the winner, or any placed horse on the grounds of interference, crossing, jostling, or any improper act or conduct of the driver of such horse. The protest may be made to a Steward BEFORE THE DRIVER LEAVES THE TRACK AND PRIOR TO ALL CLEAR BEING DECLARED.

BOOKMAKERS

The public is notified that Bookmakers must set the investor up to \$1,000 on the price shown on the Board until the horses come onto the track (approximately 7 minutes to the start of each race), after which time the limit of liability shall be \$300. In the event of a dead-heat, payment will be made on a basis of half the value of the ticket.

On all Betting tickets issued by Bookmakers the name of the horse and the amount of the Bet must be clearly written. Should a dispute arise and it is found that this has not been done, a decision may be given against the Bookmaker.

Investors must check their tickets for the correct Name of Horse and Amount, as no claim will be recognised after the acceptance of the Ticket. All credit bets must be confirmed by the Investor with the Bookmaker concerned prior to the start of the race.

No person other than the Bookmaker, or his employees shall be upon the Betting Stand of that Bookmaker.

LOST BETTING TICKET

Assistance by the Stewards in recovering bets made on the course, can only be afforded to patrons who have lost their betting ticket, if they can name the bookmaker.

PLACE TOTE

Pays First, Second and Third horse where 8 or more starters.

Pays First and Second horses only where 7, 6 or 5 starters.

Where 4 or less starters, only Win tickets will be sold.

INVESTORS SHOULD NOTE

Every purchaser of a Ticket must satisfy himself that he has received the Ticket he applied for and every holder, entitled to a dividend must see that he has proper dividend before leaving the window, as no subsequent claim will be recognised.

TOTALISATOR DUTY ACT BY-LAW 9

No dividend shall be recoverable or paid except on presentation of the ticket for which the dividend is claimed, or after the expiration of 3 months from the date of the declaration of the dividend.
