

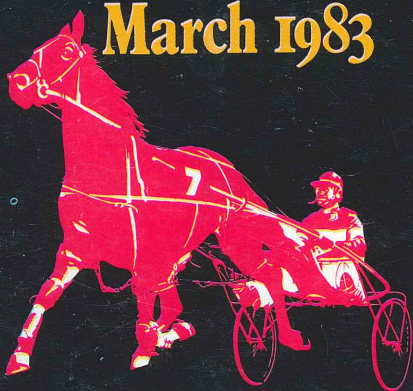

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### **BUGLE CALL**

A bugle call will be sounded over the public address system when the field leaves the birdcage.

### **LAP BELL**

As a warning to drivers the lap bell will be sounded when the field has one more round of the track to go.

### **SIREN**

Patrons are advised that a siren will be sounded if an enquiry is to be held, the result of which might effect the placings of the horses.

### **ADMISSION CHARGES**

INSIDE ENCLOSURE: Adults \$2 (Children under 15 years \$1.00).

OUTSIDE ENCLOSURE: Adults 50c (Children 15 years and under Free).

CAR PARKING: 50c.

### **SCRATCHING TIMES**

Under Rule 234 (1) (a) and (c) Horses not intending to start **MUST BE SCRATCHED BY 7.30 A.M.** on the day of the Day Meetings and by 2.00 P.M. on the day of the Night Meetings.

### **LATE SCRATCHINGS:**

Rule 234 (9): "In any race which includes balloted out, and/or eliminated with right of re-entry as provided under Rule 177/1 (F), should a horse already in the field be scratched following the re-entry scratchings time laid down under that rule, it shall be necessary for the Owner or his authorised agent to produce to the Stipendiary Stewards a Veterinary Certificate or otherwise sufficient reason for such late scratching. Failure to comply or to satisfy the Stipendiary Stewards that the scratching was warranted shall incur a fine not exceeding \$50."

The re-entry scratching time at this meeting is 12 noon on the day prior to race day.

### **UNRULY HORSES:**

If the letters U.R. appear in place of the barrier draw it means that, that particular horse has been declared unruly by the Stipendiary Stewards and such horse shall start a second line on the extreme outside from behind and clear of the front line horses. If there are other horses on the second line the horse or horses so declared unruly shall start on the extreme outside of the second line and clear of the front and second line horses.

## JETBET ON-COURSE

INTRODUCING

**THE SELL/PAY SYSTEM**

— You can bet on any Race at the one time —

### HOW TO BET

Give Operator in this order

1. Race Number
2. Bet type
3. Amount of Bet
4. Horse Numbers

### HOW TO COLLECT/BET

1. If you are betting and collecting give the Operator your winning ticket first. You can see the amount you will collect on the screen. You can then bet against your collect and either receive or pay the difference.

### HOW TO COLLECT

Take your ticket to any Jetbet window and hand it to the Operator. The screen tells you how much you will receive.

### BOX QUINELLA

Tell the Operator that you require a Box Quinella.

**Example** Race 2, Box Quinella, for \$1

Box Numbers 2, 3, 4, and 6.

This combines all four runners in the Quinella and costs \$6.

The combinations you have are 2:3, 2:4, 2:6, 3:4, 3:6, 4:6. Your ticket will print: QIN 2 x 3 x 4 x 6.

### MULTIPLE QUINELLA

Select one runner and couple it with as many other runners in the field as you wish.

**Example** Race 4, multi Quinella, for \$1 on numbers 4 with 2, 3, 7, 8 and 10.

This would cost \$5 and you win if No. 4 is placed first or second and any of the other selections fills first or second place.

## FIELD QUINELLA

Select one runner and couple it with the remainder of the field.

**Example** Race 6, field Quinella, for \$1 on field with No. 8. This would cost the total runners in the Race less one. You win if No. 8 comes in first or second.

## TREBLE

You must nominate a runner to win each of the three nominated Treble Races (or Legs).

**Example** Race 2 (Fist Leg), Treble, for \$1 on Numbers 2/4/6. Cost \$1.00.

## MULTIPLE TREBLE

You may select one or more runners for each Treble Race.

**Example** Race 2 (First Leg), Multi Treble; for \$1, on Nos. 1-2-4/2-3-6/1-4-8-12. Cost \$36.00.

## FIELD TREBLE

You can select all the runners in any one or all of the three nominated Races and would ask for a field leg.

**Example** 2/F/4 or 2/1/F or 2/F/F or F/1/4 or F/F/4 or finally F/F/F/.

The cost of the ticket would depend on number of runners in each of the legs.

# TRIFECTA BETTING

IN A TRIFECTA BET YOU MUST SELECT THREE RUNNERS IN A RACE TO FINISH FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD IN THE CORRECT ORDER.

TELL THE OPERATOR YOUR BET:

RACE NUMBER

BET TYPE (TRIFECTA)

AMOUNT (UNIT OF INVESTMENT)

RUNNER NUMBERS ( IN THE ORDER YOU WISH THEM TO FINISH, (I.E.) FIRST, SECOND, THIRD).

EXAMPLE: RACE 2

TRIFECTA

\$1

RUNNERS 1, 4, 6

TO HAVE A WINNING TICKET No. 1 MUST BE FIRST, No. 4 SECOND, AND No. 6 THIRD.

## BOX TRIFECTA

A BOX TRIFECTA COUPLES ALL RUNNERS: THEREFORE IF ANY OF THE RUNNERS SELECTED COME IN FIRST; SECOND; THIRD - YOU HAVE A WINNING TICKET.

EXAMPLE: RACE 2

BOX TRIFECTA

AMOUNT \$1

BOX RUNNER NUMBERS 1 x 2 x 4

THIS GIVES THE FOLLOWING SELECTIONS: 1-2-4, 1-4-2, 2-1-4, 2-4-1, 4-1-2, 4-2-1 AND COSTS \$6.

4 - SELECTIONS WOULD COST \$ 24

5 - SELECTIONS WOULD COST \$ 60

6 - SELECTIONS WOULD COST \$120

7 - SELECTIONS WOULD COST \$210

8 - SELECTIONS WOULD COST \$336

9 - SELECTIONS WOULD COST \$504

## MULTIPLE TRIFECTA

A MULTI TRIFECTA ENABLES YOU TO SELECT ANY NUMBER OF RUNNERS FOR EACH OF THE FIRST THREE PLACINGS, (E.G.) 1-2-4; 1-4; 1-4-6-8.

EXAMPLE: RACE 2

MULTI TRIFECTA

AMOUNT \$1

RUNNERS 1-2-4; 1-4; 1-4-6-8.

THIS COVERS A RACE FINISHING ORDER OF 1-4-6, 1-4-8, 2-1-4, 2-1-6, 2-1-8, 2-4-1, 2-4-6, 2-4-8, 4-1-6, 4-1-8, AND WOULD COST \$10.

## FIELD TRIFECTA

YOU CAN TAKE A FIELD FOR ANY OR ALL OF THE FIRST THREE PLACINGS.

EXAMPLE: 2-4-F OR 2-F-4 OR 2-F-F

T=TREBLE

TF=TRIFECTA

STEP 5 MARK RUNNER SELECTIONS

EW, W, P — Mark selections in 1st column only.

D — Mark selection in 1st and 2nd column.

T — Mark selections in 1st, 2nd and 3rd columns.

Q, F — Mark selections in 1st and 2nd columns.

For Box bets, mark all your selections in 1st column.

TF — Mark selections in 1st, 2nd and 3rd columns.

## STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

FIRST NIGHT, SATURDAY, MARCH 12th, 1983

**HOBART MOBILE PACE** — Goldie Be Good, which broke from the front line and stumbled, lost considerable ground and took no serious part. This horse was later declared unruly from mobile starts. **MAX HARVEY RESTRICTED FREE-FOR-ALL** — Shortly after the start Gaining Star broke free of interference. Another to break but settle quickly, was Petite Maitre. With approximately 450 metres to run, King Amber when making a forward move, stumbled and broke. Prince Sharvid the favourite was forced to race three wide over the last round, giving ground in the run home. Petite Maitre received a check turning for home when towards the rear of the field, this was caused when the horse attempted to improve on the inside of Prince Sharvid where there was insufficient room.

**DOMINION BREWERIES MOBILE STAKES** — Following this event M. McKendry, driver of El Roquette, was fined \$75 for failing to maintain a straight course, this resulted in Bobby Vance having to be checked out of a narrowing gap. O. Purdon, the driver of the latter, stated that the horse had come to the end of his run and his chances of finishing closer were not affected.

**TELERAD TELEVISION FIRST QUALIFYING HEAT** — Following this event, Mr T. F. Thompson, driver of The Sting had his horse-man's licence suspended up to and including the 19th March 1983, for driving in the manner which caused his own horse to break and when attempting to push John Tudor outwards his horse broke, causing a resultant severe check to Ao Marama. The winner, Wondai's Mate, paced roughly around the first turn losing a little ground.

**KUMEU TROTting CLUB FIRST QUALIFYING HEAT** — Sure Court and Scotch Notch were both slow at the start while Jenner and Great Talent both broke, the latter losing all chance.

**CALTEX DEALERS SECOND QUALIFYING HEAT** — Dillon Dale broke after 300 metres. Jilaire's Chance was sore on cooling out and was acutely lame in the near fore leg and will be further examined by a vet.

**FRANKLIN TROTting CLUB SECOND QUALIFYING HEAT** — Down South Clare broke at the start losing all chance. Basil Dean broke after approximately 60 metres free of interference. Another to make a mistake during the race was Malvena, this horse received a check with approximately 400 metres to run when Worthy Sox hung badly on to Mini's Pride, who in turn tightened Polly Lobell on to Malvena which broke. Worthy Sox was broken up when driver L. Caldwell attempted to prevent this incident occurring, Caldwell was issued with a warning to overcome this horse's hanging tendencies. In the home run both Sir Castleton and Basil Dean broke under pressure.

**TELERAD VIDEO THIRD QUALIFYING HEAT** — With approximately 500 metres to run, Melton Monarch broke. Driver B. Purdon said that he appeared to stumble, and received no interference.

**COURIER SYSTEMS HANDICAP** — On Your Mark ran in at the start this causing Poplar Country to receive a check and broke losing considerable ground. Try Phee was another to break shortly after the start, while after 500 metres Ata Lord broke free of interference losing considerable ground which was made up and this horse finished brilliantly to run a close second. Grasier broke in the run home free of interference.

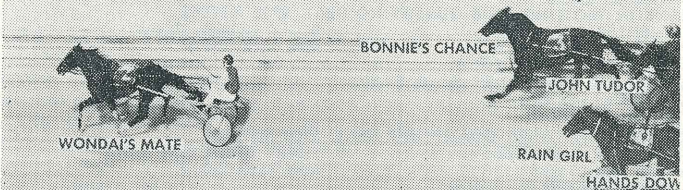

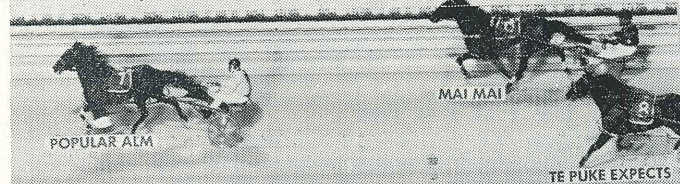

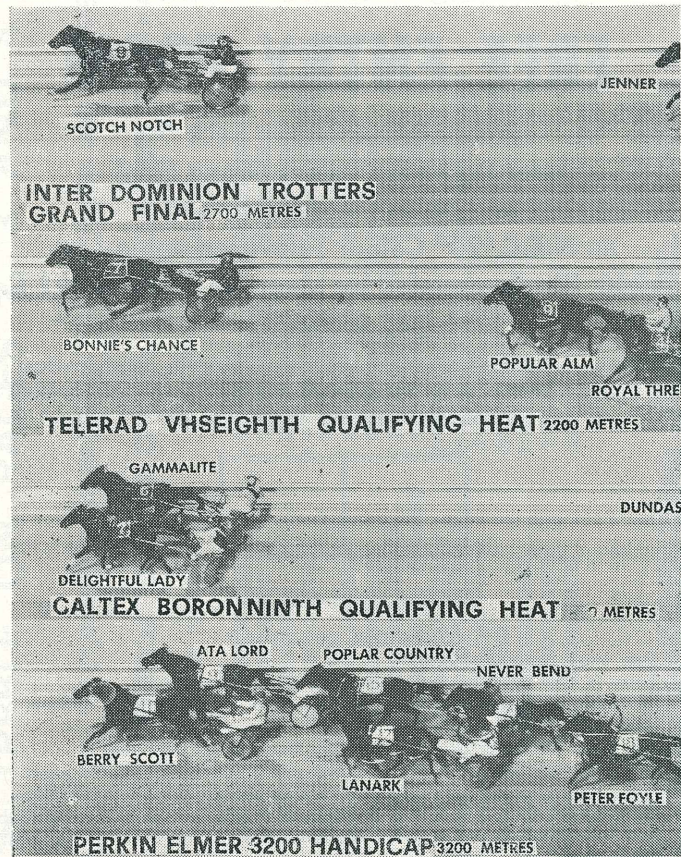
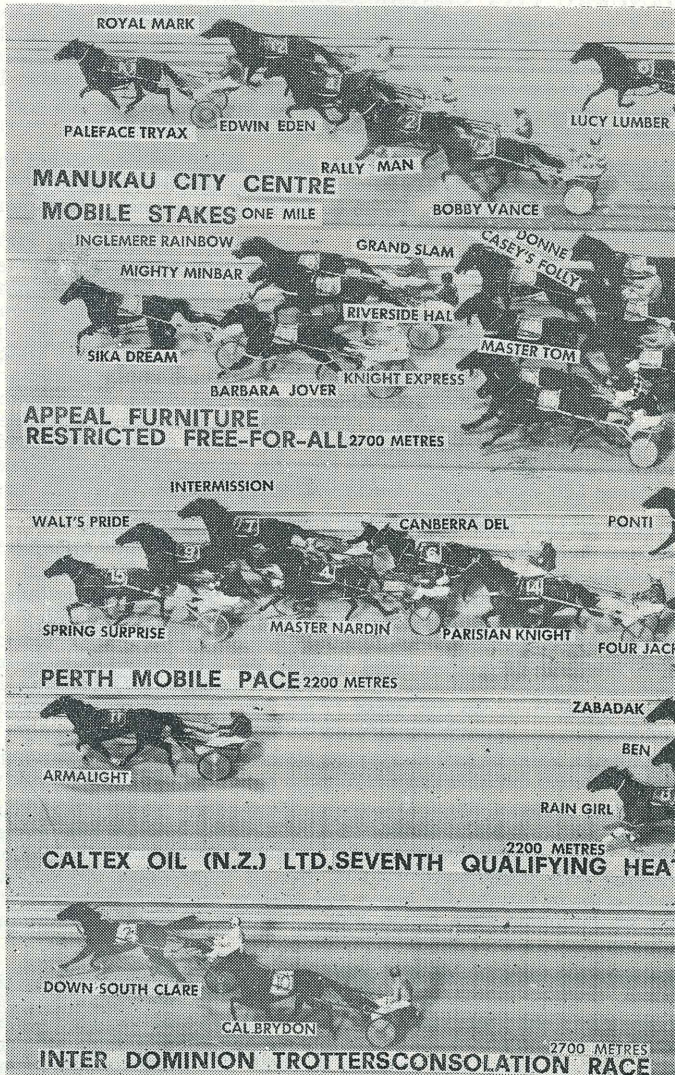
**TELERAD VHS Eighth Qualifying Heat**—Dillon Dale paced roughly shortly after the start and broke for a stride or two settling quickly.

#### POINTS SYSTEM:

Points shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of a Qualifying Division on the basis that the winner of a race of a Qualifying Division will receive in points the equivalent of the number of horses previously selected by the Auckland Trotting Club as the maximum number of horses to compete in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horse in each race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lower number in points and the third horse will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field will receive one (1) point.

The winner of each race of a Qualifying Division will receive one (1) bonus point to be added to the points already earned for that race.

There are no points allocated for fastest time.

A horse that is scratched from a race of a Qualifying Division or a horse that does not complete the race will not be allocated any points for the race of that Qualifying Division.

In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field had competed and finished the course in that particular race.

In the event of a dead-heat all points of the horses dead-heating shall be added together and equally divided.

The Judge shall place all horses in a race according to the order in which their noses reached the winning post.

In each Qualifying Division the same number of maximum points shall be allocated irrespective of the actual number of starters and irrespective of the variation of the number of Divisions on each day or night of racing.

The twelve (12) Horses which gain the greatest aggregate of points shall be eligible to start in the Grand Finals, but should circumstances warrant such a course of action the Grand Council of the Inter Dominion Conference shall have the power to increase the numbers of starters above the designated number and to select the additional starters.

In the event of two or more horses each scoring equally the minimum number of points entitling them to be eligible for the Grand Finals and thereby producing a field exceeding the safety number permitted for Alexandra Park Raceway, then the Grand Council shall decide in its discretion which of the horses with equal points shall start in the Grand Finals. The Championship Programme Committee shall be the sole judge of which horses are entitled to start in the Consolation Races.

Wherever a scratching occurs after the Barrier Draw of a Division, Consolation or Final, no horse shall change his Barrier Position or line because of such a scratching provided that where a scratching does occur on the front line horses shall have their position adjusted so as to close up all gaps left by scratchings.

#### HORSES ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE GRAND FINAL

To be eligible to compete in the Grand Final, horses shall start in each Qualifying Race unless exemption is made by the Grand Council who shall decide upon each case according to its merit.

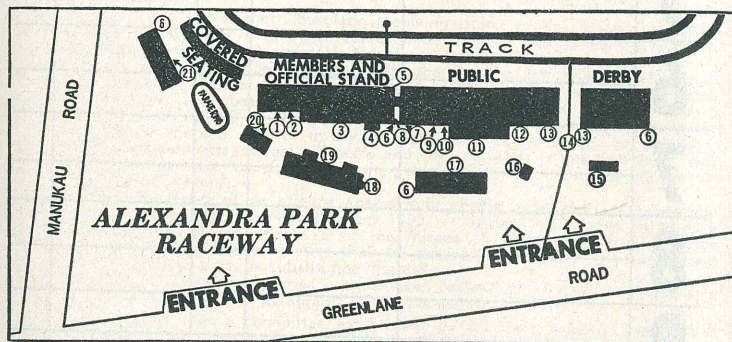

## AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB INC.

Extract from **N.Z. Gazette**, 8th June, 1978, No. 50, page 1613  
**New Zealand Trotting Conference**

IN pursuance and exercise of the power contained in section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, the New Zealand Trotting Conference resolves to and does hereby make the following rules controlling the admission of persons to all racecourses used by racing clubs which are now or may at anytime hereafter be registered with the said New Zealand Trotting Conference.

### R U L E S

(Under the Racing Act 1971)

1. These rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are published in the **New Zealand Gazette**.

2. In these rules the words "racecourse", "racing club", and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by section 2 of the Racing Act 1971, and the word "bookmaker" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by the Gaming Act 1908, or any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution of such Act.

3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from all race courses used by racing clubs which are or may at any time hereafter be registered with the New Zealand Trotting Conference while such racecourses, or any thereof are being used by any club for a race meeting, namely:

- (a) All persons under disqualification imposed under the New Zealand Rules of Racing or the New Zealand Rules of Trotting or by the racing or trotting authorities in any country outside New Zealand, which have reciprocal agreements in matters of racing or trotting with the New Zealand Racing Conference or the New Zealand Trotting Conference;
- (b) Bookmakers;
- (c) Persons convicted of theft, burglary, receiving stolen goods, robbery, unlawful taking or conversion of a motor car or other vehicle, false pretences, forgery, utterings, possession of counterfeit coin, or assault;
- (d) Persons convicted of any offence under the Gaming Act 1908, or of any of the following offences under the Crimes Act 1961: murder, attempted murder, manslaughter (not based on negligence), sections 188-204 (which relate to assaults and injuries to the person), sections 294-297 (which relate to arson or attempt thereof), crimes involving dishonesty or conspiracy to commit a crime, indecent acts, sexual offences, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
- (e) Persons convicted of an offence against any of the paragraphs of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Narcotics Act 1965, or against any of the paragraphs of sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, and the reference to the foregoing Acts shall be deemed to apply to any subsequent Act consolidating or in substitution thereof;
- (f) Persons convicted in countries outside New Zealand of offences corresponding to those mentioned in paragraph (d) or paragraph (e).

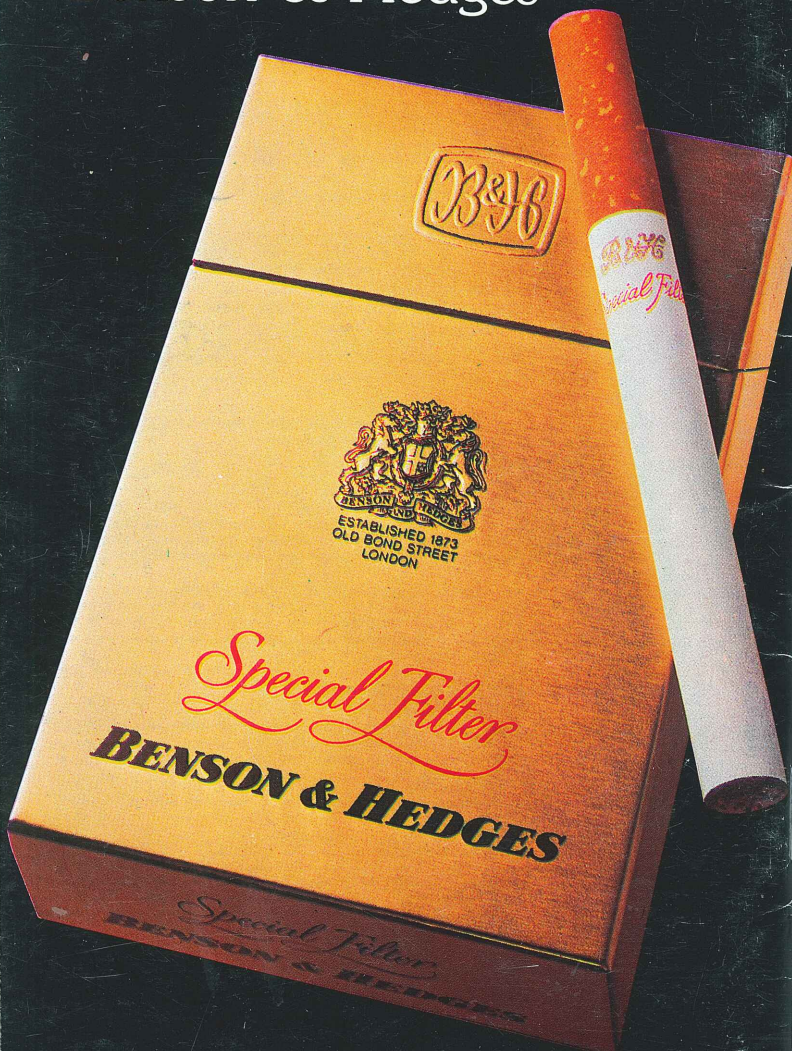
Provided always that a committee established by the New Zealand Racing and Trotting Conferences upon being satisfied as to character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of these rules should have relief from the effect thereof may grant exemption to any such person.

4. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the **New Zealand Gazette**, of 22 November 1973, on p. 2438, and which were deemed to have been revoked at midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, have effect for the purpose only of determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time before midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976. In every other respect such revoked rules thereafter have no effect. The rules previously made by the New Zealand Trotting Conference under section 101 of the Racing Act 1971, and which were published in the **New Zealand Gazette**, and shall thereafter have the effect for the purpose only determining the eligibility under the said Rules of Trotting of horses which started in races under the said Rules of Trotting at any time between midnight on the 23rd day of September 1976, and midnight on the day which these rules are published in the said **Gazette**. In every other respect such revoked rules shall hereafter have no effect.
