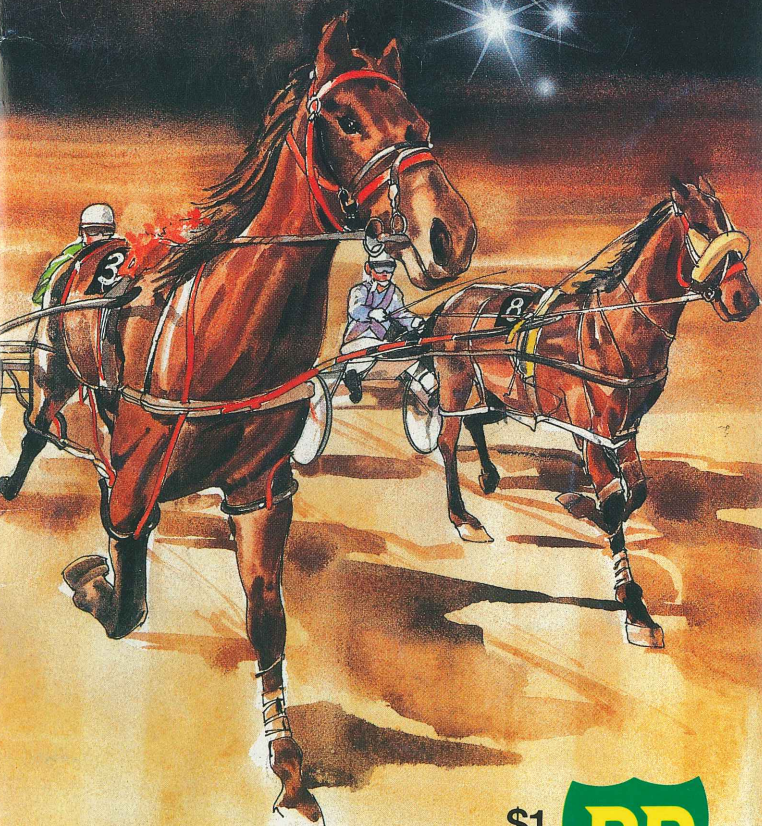

## STEWARDS' REPORT

### Race 1: ELIZABETH PIZZA HUT THREE-YEAR-OLD STAKES

M. Marozzi (MARCHE BOY) was severely reprimanded for having that pacer out of the allotted barrier position in the mobile score up.

SCOTCH GEM (D. Billinger) after having been obliged to work hard in the early stages, compounded to finish distanced. A warning was issued in respect of the race manners of this pacer.

### Race 2: SALISBURY PIZZA HUT COMBINED STAKES

RIVER HERO (J. Patrick) paced roughly in the early stages of the score up and a warning was issued.

L. Justice (KALMARI KENNY) was fined \$25.00 for having that pacer out of its allotted barrier position in the mobile score up.

SARATOGA DRIVE (L. Harding) was inclined to pace roughly over the concluding stages of the event.

BARRY BUTLER (A. Jones) hung noticeably in the run to the first corner and a warning was issued.

The reinsman's licence of R. ### Race 7: DULWICH PIZZA HUT TROTTERS FREE-FOR-ALL

R. Smith (NOTERRY) who was officially placed fourth by the Judge lodged an objection against the third place getter MARTIAL SMOKE (L. Justice) alleging that MARTIAL SMOKE had gained ground whilst in a break over the concluding stages of the event. After taking evidence from both drivers; viewing the official film of the race and acting on their own observations the protest was upheld and the placings amended to read: YANKEE'S PURCHASE, JENNY BEAR, NOTERRY and MARTIAL SMOKE. The Stewards were satisfied that L. Justice had made every effort to return MARTIAL SMOKE to its correct gait and no action was taken.

J. Barrowcliff (MINITRICK) was reprimanded for momentarily tightening the ground of ARCNESS (R. Sugars) as he shifted to a position in the one out line in the back straight on the first occasion.

R. Fewings (SPIN ATTACK) was reprimanded for momentarily taking the ground of ARCNESS (R. Sugars) as he progressed to a three wide position turning into the front straight to receive the bell.

SPIN ATTACK (R. Fewings) broke gait in the front straight in the bell lap causing ARCNESS to be further checked and a warning was issued in respect of that trotter.

### Race 8: YOU'RE WELCOME STAKES

ANDENOTLA (L. Justice) was inclined to pace roughly as that reinsman endeavoured to restrain ANDENOTLA during the early stages of the event.

### Race 9: ENFIELD PIZZA HUT STAKES

SHABOWAY (J. West) dropped a knee boot as the field raced to the turn off the back straight on the first occasion and broke gait causing FAN'S BEAUTY to be checked.

SHABOWAY again broke gait in the front straight on the last occasion momentarily inconveniencing TWO STOREY (R. Sugars). The gear was inspected by the Stewards and was found to be of good quality and the incidents noted.

It was noted that FAN'S BEAUTY which had received a check behind the galloping SHABOWAY broke gait and lost ground on the turn into the front straight on the first occasion.

MIKE'S DREAM (M. Pawlik) was noticeably held up for a run over the concluding stages of the event.

GLENVIEW (B. Ewen) paced roughly over the final lap of this event and trainer B. Ewen was advised to effect a cure.

### Race 7: BP ACHIEVER TWO-YEAR-OLD STAKES (28/1/84)

The inquiry was resumed into the reason for CHILTERN TWO (K. Brook) breaking gait in the back straight on the final occasion.

It was established at that point in time KIRRALEE ROSE (B. Webster) had hung down the track despite the efforts of its reinsman and tightened the ground of CHILTERN TWO. The nomination of KIRRALEE ROSE will be refused for a period of fourteen days for an unsatisfactory race performance.

The verandah is adorned with black polished slabs commemorating the past and present identities of Who's Who in the trotting field.

Trophies, forged together with photographs of yesteryear and all the paraphernalia associated with trotting, with this fascinating array of authentic pieces and relics, all makes a most enjoyable and interesting afternoon's entertainment.

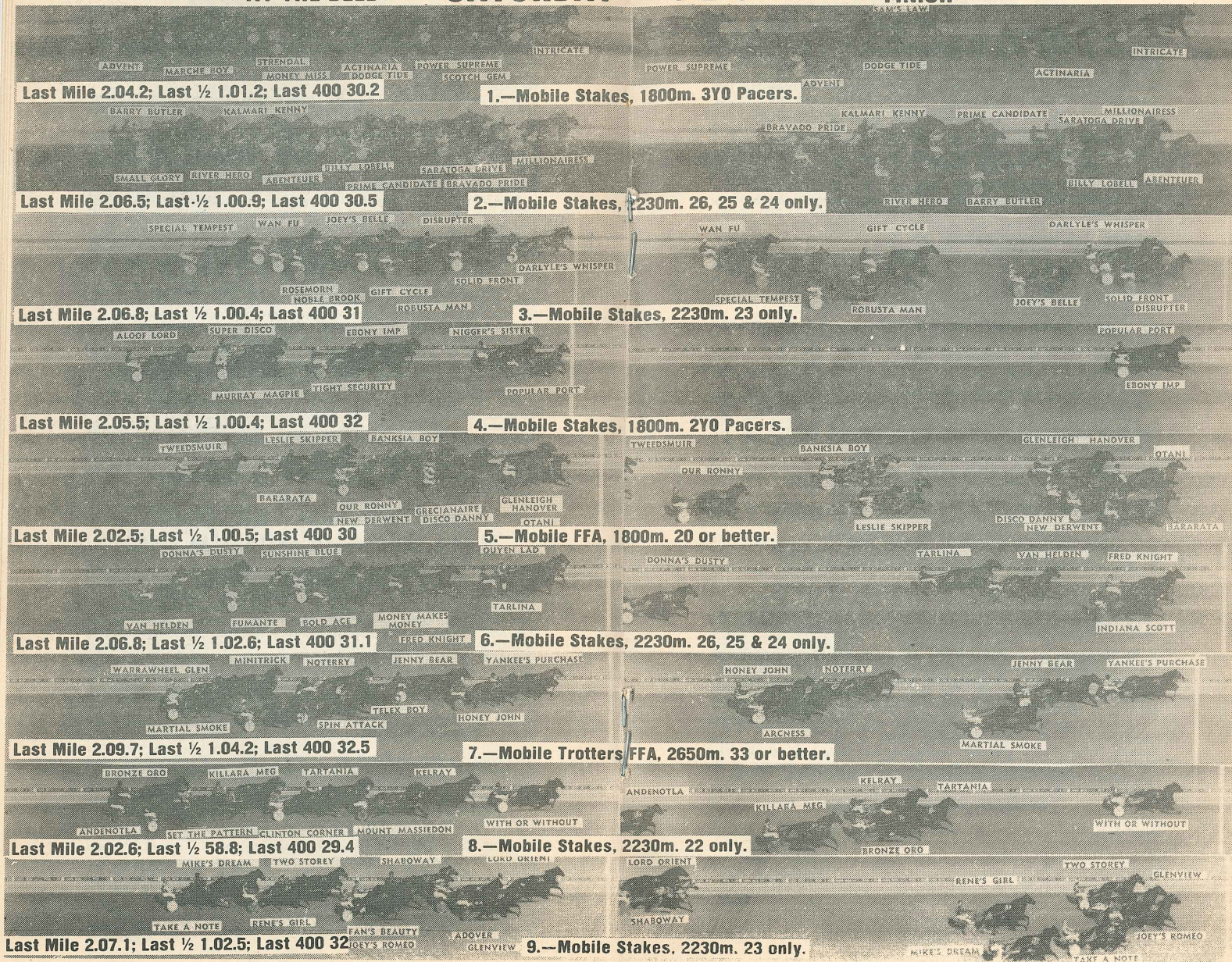

## POINTS SYSTEM

Points shall be awarded to each horse actually starting and finishing a race of a Qualifying Division on the basis that the winner will receive in points the equivalent of the maximum number of horses competing in each race of the Qualifying Divisions. The second horse in that race of the Qualifying Divisions will receive the next lowest number in points; the third horse will receive the next lower number with each horse finishing thereafter receiving in order one lower number in points than the preceding horse until the last horse finishing in a maximum field of 10 will receive one (1) point.

A horse which is scratched from a race of the Qualifying Divisions or a horse which does not complete the race, will not be allocated any points in that race.

In the event of a scratching or a horse not completing the course, points will be allocated as before with the winner and other horses finishing the race entitled to receive their maximum number of points as if a full field has competed and finished the course.

In the event of a DEAD-HEAT all points of the horses dead-heating shall be added together and divided equally.

THE TEN (10) HORSES WHICH GAIN THE GREATEST AGGREGATE OF POINTS IN THE QUALIFYING DIVISIONS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO START IN THE GRAND FINAL.

In the event of two or more horses scoring equally the minimum number of points entitling them to be eligible for the Grand Final, then thereby producing a field exceeding the number designated, then the Grand Council shall decide in its discretion which of the horses with equal points shall start in the Grand Final.

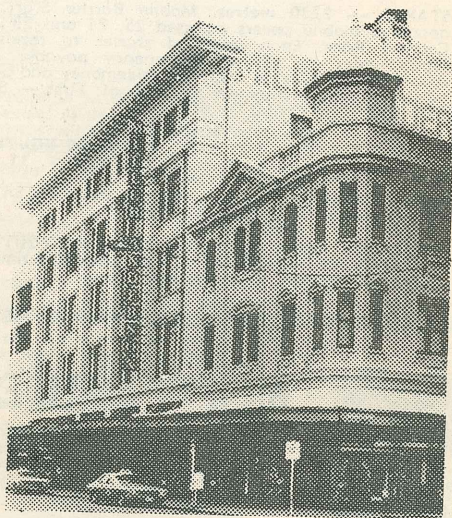

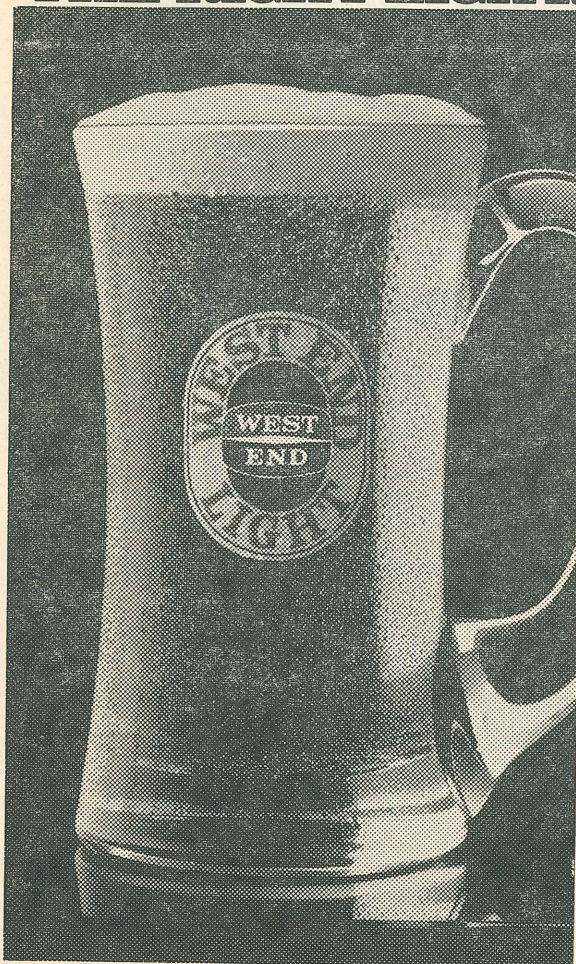
