

AUSTRALIAN TROTTING HALL OF FAME MUSEUM INC.

Set in a large purpose-built bluestone building, is Australia's National Trotting Museum, adjacent to the Globe Derby Trotting complex. The National Trotting Hall of Fame depicts the history of the trotting world, housing extensive collections of objects and archives, associated with the "light harness" horse world. Six horse stalls with carriage lights attached, each representing the States of Australia, highlighting the achievements of their dynamic performances. The New South Wales stall includes the taxidermist head of "Ribands", the first standard bred horse to better a 2-minute mile in Australia, while South Australia exhibits the skeleton and 11 pound heart of "Minor Derby", the local trotting idol.

The verandah is adorned with black polished slabs commemorating the past and present identities of Who's Who in the trotting field.

Trophies, forged together with photographs of yesteryear and all the paraphernalia associated with trotting, with this fascinating array of authentic pieces and relics, all makes a most enjoyable and interesting afternoon's entertainment.

STEWARDS' REPORT

Race 1: S.A. '84 BP INTER DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 4).

C. de Filippi (OUR MANA) was fined \$100.00 under Rule 370 (b) for shifting ground in the front straight in the bell lap when not clear of SMITHDALE LAD (W. Kersley). In the incident W. Kersley was obliged to check SMITHDALE LAD three wide and remain in that position for some considerable distance. In assessing penalty the Stewards took into consideration the fact that SMITHDALE LAD had made ground quickly to the wheel of OUR MANA.

THOR LOBELL (V. Knight) was momentarily checked as the field left the back straight on the last occasion as SMITHDALE LAD (W. Kersley) which had begun to tire, hung down the track.

All horses were pre race tested and the results returned as negative.

A swab was ordered to be taken from THE RATTLER and OUR MANA driven by J. Hurley and C. de Filippi respectively.

Race 2: S.A. '84 BP INTER DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 5).

H. McDermott (LOBELLENT) was fined \$100.00 under Rule 370 (b) for shifting ground towards the rail as the field left the back straight on the first occasion and in doing so contacting and checking GUV'S PRIDE (J. Hurley). In assessing penalty the Stewards took into consideration that contact had been slight and that GUV'S PRIDE had not broken gait.

All horses were pre race tested and the results returned as negative.

A swab was ordered to be taken from NOT BEFORE TIME (R. Adams) and GUV'S PRIDE (J. Hurley).

Race 3: S.A. '84 BP INTER DOMINION PACING CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 6).

B. Hancock (OUT FOR GLORY) was reprimanded for unduly slackening the pace in the one out line as the field progressed into the back straight on the first occasion. In the incident GAMMALITE (W. Clarke) was momentarily inconvenienced.

All horses were pre race tested and the results returned as negative.

A swab was ordered to be taken from GAMMALITE (W. Clarke) and BLACK IRISH (C. Lewis).

Race 4: S.A. '84 BP INTER DOMINION TROTTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS (Div. 3).





Hoban) to be checked. In assessing penalty the Stewards considered that extenuating circumstances existed.
